Position Summary:

As part of consultation, Treaties, Lands and Environment (TLE) coordinates participation in ecological studies and environmental monitoring throughout the Nation's Treaty and Traditional Territory. Archaeological Field Liaisons have covered these sites in the past, but as these opportunities grow, TLE is looking to recruit candidates specifically for these environment-related opportunities.

Environmental Field Liaisons help exercise the Nation's rights and jurisdiction by participating in ecological surveys, supervising species' relocations, and monitoring the environmental impacts of construction activities. Responsibilities include taking daily field notes, notifying TLE in the case of harmful activities, and representing COTTFN in the field. Candidates must be able to work independently and get themselves to site locations.

Responsibilities:

- Actively participate in and/or monitor environmental activities
- Maintain accurate daily logs and field notes
- Submit weekly documentation signed by field supervisors
- Liaise in a professional manner with others in the field

Qualifications:

- Some environmental monitoring training (e.g. Natural Resources Training Group), or equivalent experience.

Requirements:

- COTTFN band member
- Access to a reliable vehicle to get to sites throughout SW Ontario.
- Tolerance for working in outdoor environments in a wide range of weather conditions.
- Ability to walk and/or stand on various terrains for a prolonged period.
- Physically able, with or without accommodation, to extensively perform bending, kneeling, standing, lifting, and carrying objects weighing up to 50 lbs.

Work hours:

This is a casual position based on contracts received by the TLE Dept. Hours are not guaranteed. While most of the work occurs during weekday business hours, overtime may be required, and ecological surveys occasionally take place in the evening.
